- Review commands
- Ability to switch from 4/4 to 3/4 to 2/4 smoothly at 90 bpm.
- 4 measures each with a clear cut-off gesture.

Drum Major Applicants-

_____Prepare to conduct Part 1: No One Mourns the Wicked by Jay David Cook. Scores available from Ms. Jacob with QR Code to the recording (YouTube).

You will be assessed in various areas including score markings, cues, dynamic expression, creativity of gestures, steady tempo, posture, and facial expressions.

_____A leadership help session will be held prior to the audition. We will discuss the fundamentals of conducting and how to best prepare for your audition.

_____Students selected for the drum major, band captain, and guard captain position will be expected to attend the FSU MARCHING BAND LEADERSHIP CAMP held June 29– July 4th, 2025,

on the Campus of Florida State University. Exceptions will only be granted in extreme circumstances.

_____Students are encouraged to speak with and request help sessions from current leadership council members. These are not required but they are encouraged for additional feedback, as is the drum major help session. Students should speak to Ms. Jacob regarding ANY questions about leadership.

- Selected drum majors, band captain, and guard captain will be expected to attend the <u>FSU MARCHING BAND</u> <u>LEADERSHIP CAMP held June 29th– July 4th, 2025</u>, on the campus of Florida State University. Exceptions will only be granted in extreme circumstances.
- Attend ALL required guard/percussion camps (if applicable).
- Attend additional leadership training/camps over the summer (scholarships may be available).
- Attend all events on the band calendar for the **2025-2026** school year.
- Help with set-up and tear-down of all band events.
- Arrive prior to call-time to assist with duties and stay after dismissal to ensure areas are clean and orderly.
- Participate in District Solo & Ensemble.
- Audition for the Hillsborough All-County Band.
- Be a positive example to all non-leadership band students and the general school population.
- Be present at ALL band events throughout fall and spring semesters.
- Demonstrate the highest level of musicianship throughout the *entire* year.
- Maintain an acceptable GPA and maintain positive relationships with Brandon teachers/faculty.
- Be present at all leadership meetings.
- Always showcase the appropriate rehearsal etiquette.
- Help less experienced members learn marching and maneuvering skills.
- Be a social liaison for freshmen band students to make them feel welcome and included.
- Be a liaison for middle school band students to encourage community and pride for future Brandon band members.
- Help ensure the success of the Brandon Bands program.
- Be enrolled in a band/color guard course.
- Color Guard Captains will be expected to choreograph and teach performance routines including stand dances, spring showcase routines, winter concert routines, etc.
- Student leaders are expected to continue to develop their personal techniques as well as leadership skills.
- Regardless of a student leader's commitment and dedication, no student leader will "earn" absences or the right to break any commitments/expectations of the Brandon Bands program throughout the school year.
- Student leaders are held to a higher standard of musicianship/technique, behavior, and contribution to the band than non-leadership students.
- If not chosen, the student will assume their regular role in the band and give full cooperation to the other members selected and the director.
